Opening An Estate

If an individual impacted by the Flint Water Crisis has subsequently died, a **Personal Representative**, appointed by the Probate Court, has legal authority to file a claim on the decedent's behalf.

- Application for Informal Probate and/or Appointment of Personal Representative
- Testimony to Identify Heirs
- Supplemental Testimony to Identify Non-heir Devises
- Renunciation of Right to Appointment, Nomination of Personal Rep and Waiver of Notice
- Register's Statement
- Acceptance of Appointment
- Letters of Authority for Personal Representative
- Notice of Appointment and Duties of Personal Representative
- Notice to Creditors
- Inventory
- Inventory Fee Calculator
- Notice of Continued Administration
